EACH MONTH GCPC DESIGNATES AN ORGANIZATION TO RECEIVE THE COMMUNION OFFERING. You can see the list of organizations by month for 2024 [here](#); it's also posted on the Mission Bulletin board (just outside the Sanctuary doors closet to the sound booth). The Communion Offering recipient is also listed in the bulletin every Sunday. Any member can choose to give Communion Offering by either selecting "Communion" in the online giving portal, or writing "Communion Offering" on the check or envelope that you put in the offering plate.

Currently, many members give to one of the Communion Offering organizations outside of the month that is designated for it. For example, someone might give an offering for Rosehill Elementary in April, although the month designated for Rosehill is February. The many generous donations are much appreciated! Thanks as always for your kindness. However, receiving offering for a Communion Offering organization outside of the designated month creates a lot of work to track and direct those amounts correctly for Tara, our financial officer. To alleviate that burden, effective February 1, 2024, all Communion Offering received will be directed to the organization for the month it is received in. So to continue the example above, all Communion Offering received between February 1 and February 29 will be directed to Rosehill. If you would like to give to a Communion Offering recipient outside of the month designated for it, please consider giving directly to the organization. SOUPER BOWL OF CARING 2024: A GCPC tradition, the Souper Bowl of Caring is the championship of food drives! This year we're directing donations straight to ReNewed Hope Food Pantry rather than Harvesters. ReNewed Hope was founded out of the desire that no person in our community go hungry. Their mission is to feed the hungry and help our neighbors as God asked us in Isaiah 58: "... if you pour yourself out for the hungry / and satisfy the desire of the afflicted / then shall your light rise in the darkness / and your gloom be as the noonday."

Any nonperishable packaged food is welcome, but the most needed items are: *peanut butter, jelly, pasta, pasta sauce, canned fruit, canned soup, and crackers*. Please leave your donations in the Weekday Entrance bin anytime before February 1. Both Weekday Entrance bins can be used if needed!
