A MESSAGE SHARED IN OUR NOVEMBER 20 SUNDAY SERVICE, during the Stewardship Time from Dave Sutherland, chair of Generosity Team: So we've had a big bump in the number of pledges made in the past week. Thank you very much, it is very much appreciated from all of us on the Generosity Team. There are two more weeks to go until we lock in the pledges. We've been working with the Finance Team to get ready a budget ready for Session in December. One thing we have been looking at too, is how people have been giving this year. So our financial system breaks it down by those who have not given anything against their pledge this year, 0%, 1-25%, 26-50%, 51%-75%, 76%-99% and 100%. My wife Susan and I are in the 76% - 99% since we give monthly. Once next month hits, we will bump to the 100%. We do have a number of people who are still at 0%, both people who rolled over their pledge and people who also submitted a pledge. So please if you are able to, catch up as best you can. If you can't, let us know. That's okay too, we understand all circumstances. It helps us to take into account when we do the rollovers this year, should we count that as a rollover if you are unable to give this last year.
