What to bring:

(Supplies version)

- BEADS! Pony beads, alphabet beads, any bead shapes, etc.
- Elastic cording (Clear Stretch Magic brand 7mm or similar)
- Scissors
- Ruler or tape measure
- Washi tape
 (1 roll washi, or masking tape)
- Bowls for beads (ziplocs helpful)
- Fabric place mat (keeps beads from rolling and a great surface to layout your bead pattern)
- Bead board (optional)
- G-S Hypo Cement, a strong craft and jewelry glue (or super glue if you can't find it)

What to bring: (Food version)

- A dozen cookies to share
- Your own drink (with a lid)

What to wear: (Sparkly version)

- Whatever makes you comfortable, especially anything in lavender or pink, or with sparkles!
- Dress in your favorite ERA or Swiftie shirts!
- Chiefs shirt or Travis Kelce jersey
