ALL: We give thanks that God understands us, and encourages us to grow in our knowledge of God's awesome holiness.


ONE: Glorious God, You invite us to sink our roots deep into Your love and holiness, and to grow stronger each day in our faith in You.

ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS


Anyone who is in Christ is a new creation. The old life has gone; a new life has begun. Know that you are forgiven and be at peace. **Thanks be to God.**




