WELCOME/ANNOUNCEMENTS

*CALL TO WORSHIP

(Based on Genesis 1 (CEB), adapted by our youth group)

- ONE: When God began to create the heavens and the earth, God said,
- ALL: "Let there be light."
- ONE: And light broke through the deep. There was evening, and there was morning.
- ALL: And God saw that it was good.
- ONE: God shaped the sky and poured out the oceans, spread the land wide, and whispered life into soil—seeds and stems, fruit and flower, growing and reaching.
- ALL: And God saw that it was good.

- ONE: God filled the seas with swimming things, and filled the skies with flying wings. Wilderness came alive with every kind of creature; crawling, walking, leaping, lounging.
- ALL: God smiled and said: It is good.
- ONE: Then God said: "Let us make humanity in our image, to reflect our creativity, to bear love, to live in community, to care for creation as I have cared for you."
- ALL: And so we were made—beautiful, beloved, bold— every color, every kind, every one—we were made for good.
- ONE: We were not made to dominate, but to nurture. Not to consume, but to cultivate. Not to take, but to tend. We were made with purpose—to be caretakers of this world and of one another.
- ALL: So today, we come to remember who we are—created in God's image, called good, and commissioned to care.
- ONE: Let us worship the One who created all things, who called it all good, and who calls us still—
- ALL: To live with love, to serve with joy, and to rise into the sacred work of being human. Let us worship God!

CALL TO CONFESSION

We were made in the image of God—called good, called caretakers, called beloved. But sometimes we forget. We take more than we give. We ignore the cries of the earth and the pain of our neighbors. We rush past beauty. We act like it's all about us. But here's the good news: God doesn't give up on us. God invites us back—again and again—to reflect, to return, to renew. So, let's take a breath, and let's tell the truth, and let's trust in God's mercy together.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION (Together)

Creator God, we confess that we have not cared for your creation as we should. We have polluted the air, the waters, and the soil. We have filled our lives with stuff instead of meaning. We have ignored the warning signs — from melting ice to burning forests to unheard voices. We confess that we have forgotten our purpose: to love, to serve, to protect what you called "very good." We have turned away from wonder, and we have chosen convenience over compassion.

Forgive us, O God. Remind us that your Spirit still hovers, that new creation is always possible. Help us to live like we believe the earth is sacred, and that so are we. Amen.

ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS

Here's the truth: God is not done with us. From the first breath on Earth to the breath you just took — God has never stopped loving us. In Jesus Christ, we are forgiven. We are set free to begin again, to live lighter, to walk gentler, to love deeper — and to care for creation like we were always meant to. So be at peace. You are forgiven. You are free. Now, let's live like it!
