WERE YOU THERE? AN INTERACTIVE ASH WEDNESDAY SERVICE, MARCH 2, 4–7PM: Ash Wednesday will begin a season of reflections on African-American spirituals that will merge the worlds of cultural-historical black music and the season of Lent. This service will be a time of individual reflection as you move through five stations. Each station will include a Scripture reading, information about a spiritual, and a reflective activity to help you begin your Lenten Journey. Revs. Sue and Mitch will impose ashes at the conclusion of your time of worship. Come when you can, but allow 30 minutes for the experience. Ashes will be imposed until 7pm.
