For those struggling to meet basic needs, something as small as new underwear can restore dignity, comfort, and hope. Uplift is an organization that delivers hot meals and high need items to the homeless in the Kansas City area. Uplift is a 100% not for profit organization. No one in the organization gets paid for what they do. Yet every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday evening four trucks pull out from their downtown warehouse, loaded with hot meals to feed 500 to 1,000 homeless and to provide them with essential needs.
