DECEMBER DONATION PARTNER & COMMUNION OFFERING: This month's donation partner and communion offering recipient will be the Argentine Baby Closet at Argentine United Presbyterian Church. This ministry is in its 39th year of providing support to families in Kansas City, KS; Grace Covenant has been one of its faithful partners for most of that time.

The Baby Closet serves 35–40 families each month with diapers, wipes, clothing and other basics for infants and toddlers, including sleepers, blankets, burp cloths, books and larger items when available. This year the items most needed are:

- diapers sizes 5 & 6
- shoes/boots sizes 3-7
- toddler socks
- formula especially Similac (blue lid)
- new or gently used warm clothes sizes 12 months to 2T
- crib-size blankets
