MISSION

COMMUNION OFFERING RECIPIENT IN MARCH — InterFaith Hospitality Network (IHN): Although GCPC stopped participating as a host church with IHN in late 2024, IHN continues to serve clients, helping homeless families and single women gain stability. IHN provides clients with food and housing, and helps them learn to break the cycle of homelessness. During the day, IHN clients either work or stay in the JoCo IHN Family Center, learning essential life and financial skills. IHN guests receive budget counseling, case management, job search assistance, connections to community resources, and education on life, parenting, and coping skills. IHN's program works — more than 70% of the clients who graduate from IHN's program gain sustainable housing! MARCH DONATION PARTNER — GCPC's Little Free Pantry: Our donation partner in March is our own Little Free Pantry. If you haven't seen it, this pantry is found on the east end of our property along Nieman Road. We stock the pantry with nonperishable items and them being taken out of the pantry each week — sometimes the pantry is wiped clean. Volunteers check the pantry twice a week and restock it. On occasion, items are added to the pantry by members of the local community. If you'd like to donate to the pantry, please bring your donations to the Weekday Entrance anytime in March. - small jars of peanut butter
- noodle and pasta sauce
- box dinners
- individual drinks or snacks of any kind
