ON THANKSGIVING EVE, we are going to be sharing Hope Stories. RED BAG PROJECT 2025: Grace Covenant has supported Red Bag for many years, providing gifts for foster children in our community. This year we are continuing the tradition and sponsoring 27 children from 5 months old to 17 years old. Next Sunday, tables will be set up with gift requests for the foster children. Each gift is written on a small yellow Post-it note. (THIS IS A VIP — VERY IMPORTANT POST-IT NOTE!) You select the gifts you want to buy, take the Post-it-note, write your name, phone number and e-mail address. You need to buy the gift, wrap the gift and **ATTACH THE POST-IT NOTE TO THE GIFT. All gifts must be returned to the church by Sunday, November 30.** (This is the Sunday after Thanksgiving, so if you have holiday plans, please return

the gifts the Sunday before Thanksgiving — November 23.) During the first week of December, a group of volunteers will use the VIP (Post-it notes) to sort and check the gifts for each child.

We can send up to eight people on **Tuesday, November 18, 9am–3pm**. Registration closes at 12pm on Friday, November 7. You'll get an email after registering inviting you to complete the volunteer application. This must be complete by the deadline! Spots are on a first-come, first-served basis, so don't wait until the last minute.

The workday is from 9am–3pm, with a 30-minute onsite lunch break. Bring your own lunch and a full water bottle (extra water will be available on site).

- Construction volunteers do not need to have any prior experience in construction or bring any of their own tools; we will give you all of the education and tools you need!
- All registered volunteers will receive their assignment location via automated e-mail three days prior to the volunteer day.
- In case of inclement weather, please call our Weather Hotline at 816-897-7799 to hear the recorded message for any cancellations or changes. We update the message by 7:15am each morning.
- We ask that all volunteers stay the full day, from 8:30am to 3pm
- We will have 30 minutes set aside for lunch time. You will need to provide your own lunches. Feel free to bring your lunch or have lunch delivered to the site.
- We highly recommend you bring a water bottle with you.
- Please wear clothes you don't mind getting dirt, mud or house paint on, and wear sturdy/closed toe and heeled shoes (NO flip flops, sandals or crocs!) If you have work gloves, please bring them.
- Dress for the weather. If there has been rain on previous days, be prepared for the sites to be muddy.
- The use, purchase and possession of alcohol, drugs and weapons are forbidden on Habitat KC property and volunteer sites.
- All volunteers must be 16 or older to volunteer. Volunteers under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
