THANK YOU FOR TAKING SO MANY RED BAG GIFT TAGS LAST WEEK. (You all are awesome!) A quick review: 1) buy the gift, 2) wrap the gift, 3) attach the *Very Important Post-It Note* to the gift, and 4) return the gift to church by December 1.

Some helpful hints:

- 1. Consider getting a gift receipt to put in with clothes and shoes in case the size or style doesn't work for the child.
- 2. If your gift requires batteries, please include them with your gift.
- 3. Everyone likes getting a Christmas stocking—please remember to sew or pin the top of the stocking so the goodies stay inside.
- 4. PLEASE attach the Very Important Post-It Note to the gift when you bring the gift to church. The Very Important Post-It Note is how we know who gets the gift. We will remove the Very Important Post-It Note when we are packing the Red Bag for the child.
