# **Transition Update**

The Session and I agreed to another one-year interim contract. We are working to finish some things and to schedule a time for the Session to meet with COM about options to change my pastoral designation and enable me, if all parties are willing and this seems like a good fit, to remain as pastor for a longer time frame.

We continue to work on what the identity of Grace Covenant will be moving forward. I was struck by a line in Dr. King's sermon "Transformed Non-Conformist" which you can find in the worship bulletin from Jan 19th. He said "... [the church has conformed to] the status quo of the world. Ever since that time the church has been like a weak and ineffectual trumpet making uncertain sounds, rather than a strong trumpet sounding a clarion call for truth and righteousness."

It makes me wonder, who would it look like for GCPC to live into being a strong trumpet? What is it we are called to do to bring about righteousness and truth in the world?

## Clerk's Corner

The January session meeting was held early in the month due to Martin Luther King, Jr. Day and many teams had not met since Christmas.

We approved a renewal of Karen's Transitional Pastor contract for another year (Feb. 2025-Feb. 2026). The transition team will be sending a written survey out to the congregation soon. The information from that survey along with the information gathered on Sunday mornings in November will be used as a starting point for identifying our next pastor. We have heard that many in the congregation would be interested in having Karen stay in a more permanent role. One option we are discussing with the Commission on Ministry is hiring Karen as a Designated Pastor. A Designated Pastor is kind of a sweet spot between a Transitional Pastor and a Called and Installed Pastor. A Designated Pastor is hired by contract, not call, but it is a contract with the congregation for a defined term (typically 1, 3, or 5 years), which can be renewed. (As a Transition Pastor, Karen has a contract with the Session, not the Congregation, for a one-year term).

Because we did not have 2024 year-end financials yet, we opted NOT to approve a 2025 budget. We are very close to having a balanced budget and plan to approve one in February.

Karen is initiating discussions with different members involved in our music ministry about the future of that ministry and what it might look like. Music at Grace Covenant has always been exemplary, but this is not the same world, community, or congregation that we lived in 5 or 10 years ago and we want to move our music ministry forward with the congregation that we are and are becoming.

The 2024 Clerk's report was approved. We started 2024 with 365 members and ended the year with 366. We gained seven new members and lost six; of those six losses, five were deaths. We are excited about another class of new members joining us in the next month or so. Officers of the Corporation for 2025 were elected and plans for the Annual Meeting were solidified. While the program will continue through 2025 with the motel model, your prayers and financial support are more important than ever.
