DECEMBER DONATION PARTNER AND COMMUNION OFFERING RECIPIENT: This month's offering will support the Argentine Baby Closet at Argentine United Presbyterian Church. This ministry is in its 38th year of providing support to families in Kansas City, KS, and Grace Covenant has been one of its faithful partners for most of this time. The Baby Closet serves 45–50 families each month with diapers, wipes, clothing and other basics for infants and toddlers, including sleepers, blankets, burp cloths, books and other baby equipment (when available). This year the items most needed are:

- diapers sizes 4 & 5
- shoes/boots sizes 3-7
- formula especially Similac (blue lid)
- toddler finger foods (Puffs, yogurt bites, etc.)
- new or gently used warm clothes sizes 18 months to 2T

UPDATE ON THE GOOD FAITH NETWORK: As we mentioned earlier this year, the Good Faith Network is composed of faith-based organizations and individuals who seek to foster a more just society. For the past several years the Network has focused on the need for a mental health crisis center, the need for affordable housing and the need to respond to homelessness. This past November the Network members voted to add a fourth area of need related to elder care.
